Fact Sheet

Kennesaw State University is the third-largest university in Georgia, with 24,600 students. The University is one of the largest producers of teachers in chemistry, biology and physics in the University System of Georgia. With almost 600 students, the College of Science and Mathematics has the largest number of undergraduate chemistry majors in the USG.

College of Science and Mathematics

- Nearly 2,700 students declared majors
- 1,750 students seeking degrees in biology, biotechnology, chemistry or biochemistry
- 166 faculty members published 142 peer-reviewed articles in the past year
- \$1,752,117 in federal, state and local grants awarded to faculty since July 2012
- \$21 million building is expected to achieve Leadership in Energy and Environmental Design (LEED) Gold certification
- 73,280 square foot building houses six teaching labs and 17 research labs
- Fifth floor will be developed in the future as science programs grow
- Classes in the new lab building begin Spring 2013
- The Beaker Brew café in atrium will open Spring 2013
